Ever heard of *Holy Humor Sunday*? No? I hadn't either until about a few years ago. The idea of setting aside one Sunday each year to celebrate God's gift of laughter and joy may be fairly new to me, but it's got a long and rich history in many congregations around the world – and we're going to celebrate it on April 7! What a way to start living into the meaning of Easter faith!

Holy Humor Sunday (also known as Laughter Sunday, Hilarity Sunday, God's Laughter Sunday, Bright Sunday, or Holy Fools Sunday) has its roots in a number of different Christian traditions.

Churches in 15th century Bavaria used to celebrate the Sunday after Easter as *Risus Paschalis* ('God's Joke,' or 'the Easter laugh'). Priests would deliberately include amusing stories and jokes in their sermons in an attempt to make the faithful laugh. After the service, people would gather together to play practical jokes on one another and tell funny stories. It was their way of celebrating the resurrection of Christ – the supreme joke God played on Satan by raising Jesus from the dead.

The observance of *Risus Paschalis* was officially outlawed by Pope Clement X in the 17^{th} century. Perhaps people were having too much fun.

In the Orthodox tradition, people would gather on Easter Monday to tell jokes and funny stories, and to dance and eat together.

Other traditions celebrate *Laetare Sunday* (also known as 'Mothering Sunday') on the fourth Sunday in Lent. "Laetare" simply means 'rejoice,' and comes from the opening collect for that day: *"Rejoice with joy, you that have been in sorrow."* On this Sunday, the usual Lenten purple vestments and altar cloths are replaced by rose-colored ones instead. Flowers (not normally present during Lent) are also brought into the sanctuary.

In 1988, the Fellowship of Merry Christians began encouraging churches to resurrect some of these Christian traditions—to celebrate the grace and mercy of God through the gift of laughter and joy.

Here at Friendship, we are a people of laughter and joy, and so it's absolutely appropriate for us to pick up this mantle of praise and celebrate Holy Humor Sunday on this first week after Easter! So, join us and be prepared to have some fun!

During March, Troop 149 Scouts and parents spent a long weekend on the Georgia coast at Sapelo Island. Despite the initial very rainy travel and arrival day, we enjoyed the weekend and got to spend some time touring the island, visiting the lighthouse, wading with a seine net under the supervision of a GA DNR staffer, and lots of good camping activities. At the end of April, we will be taking part in a district Camporee in Gainesville, with a "highland games" theme.

At Troop meetings, Scouts have been enjoying the longer daylight hours for activities and games. They have been working on merit badges including Sustainability, Personal Fitness, and Programming, and also got to take part in numerous badges at the district's "Advance-a-Rama" held at UGA. At our semi-annual Court of Honor at the end of March, we recognized over a dozen rank advancements and three times that many merit badges that our Scouts had completed. During April, we are continuing with additional merit badges plus advancement opportunities on citizenship, nature, and more. Scouts have started signing up for our week of resident camp at Camp Rainey Mountain this summer, and our program selections have been confirmed for the group of us traveling to Kandersteg International Scouting Centre (KISC) in Switzerland this summer as well.

Several of our Scouts are making good progress on proposing and undertaking community service projects, including Garrett Bannevans' project of cleanup and creating new seating for the church amphitheater area, with additional projects this month expected for erosion control at the front of the church (Sebastian Baggett), adopt-a-mile (Jackson Arledge), stair construction at the State Botanical Garden (Andrew Jones), and trail maintenance at Butterfly Dreams Farm (Martin Raybon).

Additionally, at the Troop Court of Honor, I announced that I will transition out of the Scoutmaster role this fall, upon completing 30 years in that position in August, and current Assistant Scoutmaster Rick Ormsby will take over the Scoutmaster role.
